
Computer Q & A

Q: How can I speed up my internet connection?

A: DSL and cable are the fastest ways to speed up any connection if you are willing to pay the extra money. However, there are other options available from most internet providers that are just a few dollars more than you may be paying for dialup. For example, NetZero has a fast dialup connection that costs \$14.95/ month. It is not DSL, but it is quite a bit faster than regular dialup. Check with your local phone service provider, they may be running a special that includes your telephone service as well.

Q: I can't read PDF attachments, why?

A: Most likely this is because you do not have the latest Adobe Reader. You can download the latest version from www.adobe.com.

Q: How do I convert a document from Microsoft Word, Excel, etc. to PDF?

A: Open the document that you created in Microsoft Word, Excel, etc. Click Print, Select PDF Creator from your list of printers. Click OK. Name the document and click save. The document will now be converted to PDF. If you do not have the PDF Creator installed, login to www.wcg.org/online and click on Software on the left side of the screen. Select PDF Creator from the list and install.

Q: What is the best virus scanner to use?

A: Most internet providers provide their users with free virus scanners. However, if your provider does not, we have listed several free virus scanners on the WCG online website at www.wcg.org/online (under "software"). These scanners work with all versions of windows.

Q: I am thinking about purchasing a new computer for my church. Can you help?

A: You may call the WCG computer help desk at 800.350.4466 and we will be glad to give you recommendations concerning computer purchases. Generally, deals are best near the end of the month. If purchasing from Dell Computers, the best time is at the end of their fiscal year (the end of January) or the end of one of their quarters (the end of April, July or October).

Computer Q & A

Q: How do I customize Microsoft 2007 Word, Excel & PowerPoint?

A: By customizing the *Quick Access Bar* of these 2007 programs, many common actions (Print Preview, Save As, etc.) can be accomplished with a single mouse click. Follow these steps:

- Open the Microsoft 2007 program where you want to customize the Quick Access Bar (each program must be set up separately).
- At the top of your screen locate the symbols that look like the picture at left. Click on the dropdown arrow (noted by the red arrow) and select More Commands
- Click the down arrow under Choose Commands From (next to Popular Commands) and select All Commands
- All command options are now displayed. Scroll through this list and select the commands that you commonly use and either double click each command or highlight it and click the add button
- After you have selected all the commands you want to use, click OK
- Your Quick Access Bar will now permanently display all of your choices

WCG Next 2009: Sharing God's love and life

Come to a 2009 regional conference to be inspired, encouraged, and outfitted for our shared journey as a church to WCG Next.
