The GCnext fund supports GCnext-related mission initiatives that cannot be fully funded by regular denominational income.

G@next current initiatives

Here are some of the ways that GCnext partners are planting seeds for GCI's next generation. We invite your church to join in.

• Conferences and training We help fund annual Converge conferences that gather young leaders, Church-Next workshops that equip church planters, and GCI intern gatherings.



- GenMin initiatives We help fund the work of GenMin staff who invest in our camp, missions and young leader development ministries.
- Internships We help fund the staff who work in our GCI Intern Program.
- Church planting (CMM) initiatives We help fund staff to invest in the training of new church planters and the formation and support of regionally-based church planting support networks.
